Landis Communities Report May 5, 2021

Today's report does not include the usual charts, as there has been very little change from last week. There has been a small increase in overall vaccination rate of team members to 55%. This will slightly increase again later this week, after the scheduled vaccine clinic by Phoebe Pharmacy. Other vaccination rates remain unchanged.

As a reminder, vaccines are available to Landis Communities residents, clients and team members through Phoebe Pharmacy, located on the Landis Homes campus. Vaccination clinics at Phoebe Pharmacy are held the first and third Thursday of each month from 1:30-3:30 p.m. To schedule an appointment, ask questions or voice concerns, please contact Jenny Sheckells at <u>jsheckells@landis.org</u> or 717.381.3573.

We are very grateful no new cases of COVID-19 were reported April 28 – May 4, 2021 among residents, clients or team members. Sadly, one Healthcare resident reported as positive last week, has passed away.

Governor Wolf announced this week that COVID-19 mitigation orders, except masking, will be lifted on Memorial Day, Monday, May 31, 2021. The current order requiring Pennsylvanians to wear masks will be lifted when 70% of PA residents age 18 and older are fully vaccinated. Until then, face coverings should be worn in accordance with the latest guideline from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). See the reverse side of this report for a graphic that depicts these recommendations.

On the Landis Homes campus, the residential living reopening plan will continue to consider these guidelines, along with the Lancaster County COVID-19 positivity rate, in determining next steps for allowing visitors in common spaces. The current rate of 7.7% indicates a medium risk of transmission.


