Landis Communities Report July 28, 2021

The overall Landis Communities team member vaccination rate is at 62.5%. Team members, residents, clients and family members may sign up for the vaccination clinics held at Phoebe Pharmacy on the Landis Homes campus the first and third Thursday of each month from 1:30-3:30 p.m. To schedule an appointment, ask questions or voice concerns, please contact Jenny Sheckells at jsheckells@landis.org or 717.381.3573.

The COVID-19 case reported this week involves a fully vaccinated team member so is considered a “breakthrough case.” Because of when this team member last worked, there was no impact on visitation for residents or concern for exposure.
