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Landis Communities Report October 6, 2021

This report contains information updated over the past two weeks.

The overall Landis Communities team member vaccination rate is currently at 70%.

As previously shared, Landis Communities is instituting a four-phase plan to require COVID-19 vaccination as a condition of employment.

Phase 1 of the plan, requiring new hires to be vaccinated, unless they have a religious or medical exemption, is being implemented.

Phase 2 team conversation have concluded. A few individual conversations have yet to take place.

Phase 3, applying for religious or medical exemptions, will begin soon. The considerations team members granted exemptions will need to take in areas like use of PPE and regular testing has been completed and will be shared with team members who request applications.

Phase 4 vaccination clinics have been added to the schedule to increase the opportunity for vaccines. This schedule will be shared with team members later this week. The regular clinics for residents and team members continues to be held at Landis Homes on the first and third Thursday of each month from 1:30-3:30 p.m. Please contact Jenny Sheckells at jsheckells@landis.org or 717.381.3573 to schedule an appointment.

Eight team members tested positive since last report. On the Landis Homes campus, two work in Healthcare, three in Personal Care and one in Residential Living. The other two are Landis at Home caregivers. Four of the eight had not been vaccinated.

One of the positive cases in Healthcare resulted in visitation restrictions for a couple days until outbreak testing could be completed. No positive cases were identified in Healthcare or Personal Care residents at Landis Homes.

Eight positive COVID-19 cases were reported for Landis Homes Residential Living. Five of the eight residents have completed their isolation period as of this communication. Three remain in isolation. Contact tracing has revealed no community spread. The eight cases were located throughout the RL campus including apartments and cottages. Seven of the eight had been vaccinated and the other was advised not to by a physician.

Bekah Johnsen, Director of Landis Homes Residential Living, shared the following statement: *“We continue to ask residents to wear a face covering when in common areas and to practice good hand hygiene. Please alert a campus nurse if you are feeling ill or if you are being tested for COVID-19. This allows us to support you and to be prepared with the appropriate PPE (personal protective equipment) should we make a visit to your home. The RL team works closely with residents to explain isolation and quarantine guidelines and to support residents while they are awaiting test results or recovering in their home. Since the start of the pandemic in 2020, we have had no evidence of community spread in RL. We believe this is due in part to our isolation and quarantine practices but also thanks to our amazing residents who have been open and honest in sharing with us and honoring one another with their choices. Thank you for your commitment to the health and safety of our campus and those that live and work here.”*

Two Landis Adult Day Services clients also tested positive.
