- **Testing –** As routine testing of residents and team members continues, we are happy to report that the 261 team members tested on September 29 were all negative. This week 82 residents and 245 team members were tested. All the resident tests have come back negative. Team member tests are still pending.
- Healthcare Reopening If all team member result are negative again this week, Healthcare will move to Step 2 of reopening. We will share this news as soon as possible.
- Personal Care Reopening Personal Care remains in Step 3 of reopening.
- Compassionate Caregivers A system for allowing Compassionate Caregivers is nearly complete. Families will be notified as this important way of connecting with loved ones becomes available.
- **Residential Living Reopening** The Landis Homes Green Phase Reopening document was placed in mailboxes yesterday. It reflects the announcements made in these updates since it was originally released in July. We will continue to let you know of changes.
- Corn Pickin' 5k this event, hosted by Oregon Dairy to benefit the Landis Homes Caring Fund will take place this Saturday morning. Extensive COVID-19 protocols have been put in place for runners and walkers, including wearing masks before and after the race and staying a corn stalk apart (that is just about 6 feet!). Start times will be staggered to keep the group size down so participants will come through South Campus and around the ponds in waves between 8:00 and 9:00 a.m. Residents may step outside
